The Spider's Web:

The Spider's web gives us a graphic picture of the human life pattern. The spider spins long, thin strands and attaches them to nearby objects like anchors. Then it lays cross-strands by circling the structure over and over to create a woven pattern. We may see these anchored strands as significant times and experiences of our lives — birth, graduation, marriage, and others. The circling strands tie these experiences together with the contributions of other persons, places, and things that influence our thinking.

When a strand is broken, the spider reinforces the structure. And after a bad experience, we also make adjustments in life. The experience could be a death, a separation, or a financial setback. Sometimes we need to change our direction or location, mend a relationship, alter our thinking, or seek new goals to hold our life structure together.

The children explored various professions such as doctors, firefighters, pilots, chefs, and broadcasters. Each child had the chance to work and earn KidZos.

Children visited hospital, learned basic medical procedures, including how to perform CPR and take care of patients.

At the fire station, they dressed up as firefighters and participated in a mock rescue mission.

In the aviation center, children acted as pilots, taking control of a simulated flight and learning about how airplanes work.

They also visited the supermarket and learned about business management, teamwork, and customer service, and many more activities were there. All children enjoyed this picnic and left with lot of beautiful memories. As a Sunday school superintendent first for most I thank God for his bestowing His grace upon us and making this picnic a memorable one for all our children and parents .
